

Tech Update Quiz for Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

1. What did the recent study by Zonfrillo et al. find emergency room doctors believed about giving CPS education at discharge? How many demonstrated adequate knowledge of CPS messages?
 - a. 98% believed it is important, but only 71% had adequate CPS knowledge
 - b. 85% believed it is important, but only 36% had adequate CPS knowledge
 - c. 74% believed it is important, but only 41% had adequate CPS knowledge
 - d. Less than half believed CPS education is important, but only 20% had adequate CPS knowledge
2. When using upright vests and harnesses, what features (in addition to height and weight requirements) are essential to check for each specific product? (*Check all that apply*)
 - a. Lumbar support provided by the product
 - b. Head support provided by the product
 - c. Use with lap-belt-only seat belts
 - d. Tether requirements
 - e. Rear-facing guidelines
3. TRUE or FALSE (*circle the correct answer*): If a school bus has lap-shoulder belts, it is okay for children to use belt-positioning booster seats in those seating positions.
4. TRUE or FALSE (*circle the correct answer*): Conventional car seats are allowed for use on school buses.
5. When trying to fit three CRs in a crowded rear seat, some tricks to try might include: (*Check all that apply*)
 - a) Rearranging seating positions
 - b) Changing installation methods
 - c) Recommending different CRs that might fit better
 - d) If you know it won't work, telling the parent to get a new car or new CRs without even trying
