

Tech Update Quiz for Continuing Education Units (CEUs) Summer 2009

1. What are the international side testing standards? (*circle the correct answer below*)
 - a. None
 - b. FMVSS 213
 - c. FMVSS 208
 - d. SAE 402.3

2. According to the LATCH Working Group, when is it acceptable to use LATCH with a BPB? (*circle the correct answer below*):
 - a. If the CR manufacturer allows it and the weight of the child does not exceed the vehicle’s maximum LATCH anchor weight limits
 - b. If the CR manufacturer allows it, there is no interference with proper belt positioning and the LATCH attachments are aligned with the belt anchors.
 - c. If the CR manufacturer allows it, there is no interference with proper belt positioning and the LATCH attachments are aligned between the seat belt anchors.
 - d. If the CR and vehicle manufacturer allows it, there is no interference with proper belt positioning and the LATCH attachments are aligned with the belt anchors.

3. All of the following must be met to allow use of inboard anchors for a CR installation EXCEPT (*circle the correct answer below*):
 - a. Spacing between lower anchors must be within 280 and 400 mm
 - b. The center seating position cannot have a fold-down armrest.
 - c. There must not be more than one CR LATCH connector attached to any one inboard anchor.
 - d. There must not be any contact or obstruction of the seat belts being used in the outboard positions.

4. TRUE or FALSE (*circle the correct answer*): Over the last three decades, the obesity rate for children ages 2 to 5 has doubled and for children ages 6 to 11 it has tripled.

5. TRUE or FALSE (*circle the correct answer*): All child restraint recalls require action by the caregiver for the child restraint to be used safely for transportation.
