

Tech Update Quiz for Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

1. Which of the following is NOT likely to happen if a technician does not check a convertible or all-in-one child restraint for the correct belt path location of lower attachments?. (*circle the correct answer below*)
 - a. The lower attachments might not be moved from the rear-facing belt path to the forward-facing belt path resulting in an incorrect installation.
 - b. The forward-facing CR will be installed at an angle that is too reclined if the lower attachments are not moved from the rear-facing belt path to the forward-facing belt path.
 - c. The LATCH strap might be threaded in front of the harness so that the harness can not be tightened correctly.
 - d. The LATCH strap might be threaded in front of the harness so that the installation will not be tight enough.
2. TRUE or FALSE (*circle the correct answer*): According to a 2008 analysis of crash data from the Partners for Child Passenger Safety (PCPS) project of The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP), children less than age 3 years seated in the center rear have a 35 percent lower risk of injury than those in rear-seat side positions.
3. Fifteen-month-old Anna weighs 18 pounds and arrives forward facing in an E-Z-ON Adjustable Vest with its zipper opening in the front. The vest has been connected to the 1990 Plymouth Acclaim sedan’s center rear lap belt, where there are no tether anchors. Which of the following is NOT considered to be misuse? (*circle the correct answer below*)
 - a. The child is under weight for this vest
 - b. The vest should be worn with zipper down the child’s back
 - c. A tether is required with this vest
 - d. None of the above.
