**Diana Dias named to National Child Passenger Safety Board**

Itasca, IL – The National Child Passenger Safety Board (NCPSB) is proud to announce the appointment of Diana Imondi Dias, traffic safety education specialist at AAA Northeast, to its Board. Dias, one of five new members, will serve as an appointed member representing the American Automobile Association (AAA). This is her second appointment; Dias also served on the Board from 2009-11 representing the Public Health community. She will now represent AAA on the Board.

“Through her work, Diana is changing attitudes toward child passenger safety,” said Amy Artuso, NCPSB secretariat and program manager at the National Safety Council. “We are excited to have her join our Board and help advance our mission of saving lives and preventing injuries.”

Dias became a certified child passenger safety technician in 2007 and an instructor soon after. Shortly after becoming certified, Dias was involved in a serious crash. The vehicle was damaged beyond recognition, but Dias’s son was unharmed, thanks in part to the five-point harness he was wearing.

“Living this experience made me even more passionate and determined to educate parents and caregivers through my work,” Dias said.
