Lt. Lonny Haschel Named to National Child Passenger Safety Board

Itasca, IL – The National Child Passenger Safety Board (NCPSB) is proud to announce the appointment of Lieutenant Lonny Haschel who will serve as the Board’s Public Safety/Law Enforcement Representative. Lt. Haschel is a Public Information Officer with the Texas Department of Public Safety/Texas Highway Patrol where he has served for twenty-four years.

Lt. Haschel jokes about how he got his start in child passenger safety. “Like most police officers I was ‘voluntold’ to attend a certification class as a job requirement, but I was very inspired by my instructors to work hard to ensure our precious cargo is safe on our roadways,” Lt. Haschel said. He was originally certified as a technician in 2000 and became an instructor in 2001.

Lt. Haschel has had great success in collaborating with other agencies and businesses over the past 16 years to improve child passenger safety education in the region. The local Safe Kids Coalition, recently celebrating its 25th anniversary, has served as a key partner in this effort.

In addition to instructing child passenger safety certification courses, Lt. Haschel also instructs NHTSA’s Child Passenger Safety School Bus Safety course, as well as the Safe Travel for All Children: Special Needs course.
