Course Registration and Learning Portal Access

You will be registered for the Hybrid course by an Administrator.

1. Once you are registered for the National Child Passenger Safety Technician Hybrid Certification course, you will receive two emails from training@cpsboard.org concerning the **Child Passenger Safety Learning Portal**

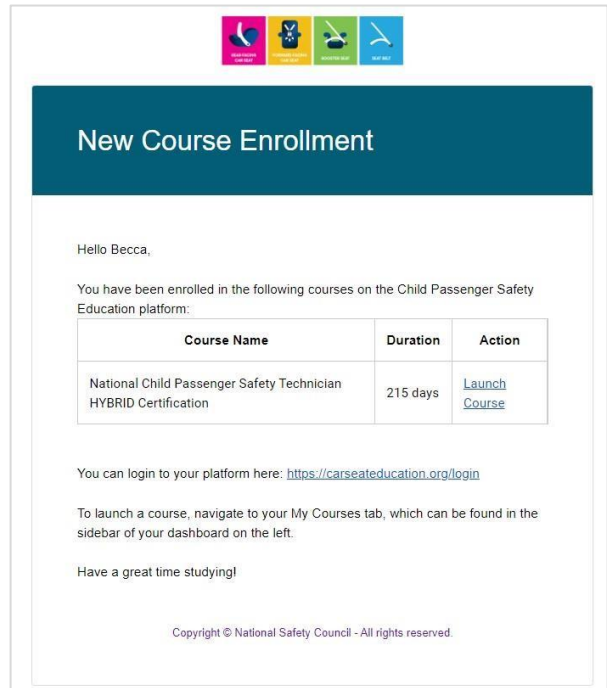
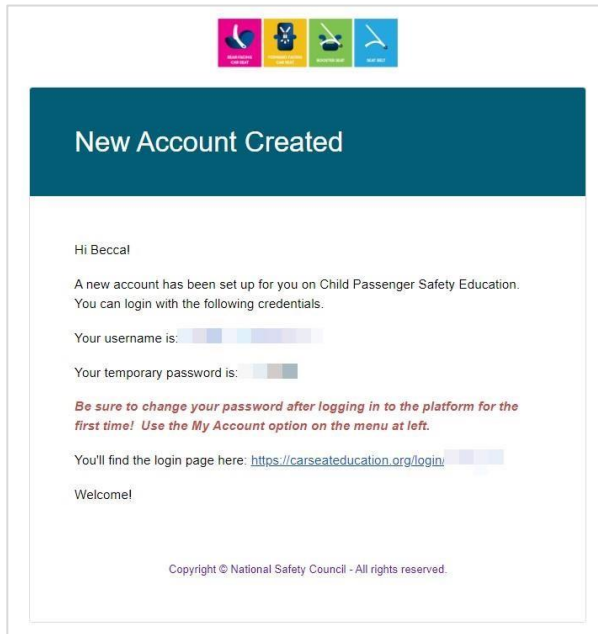

The first email confirms creation of your account on the Learning Portal. The second email confirms your enrollment in the course.

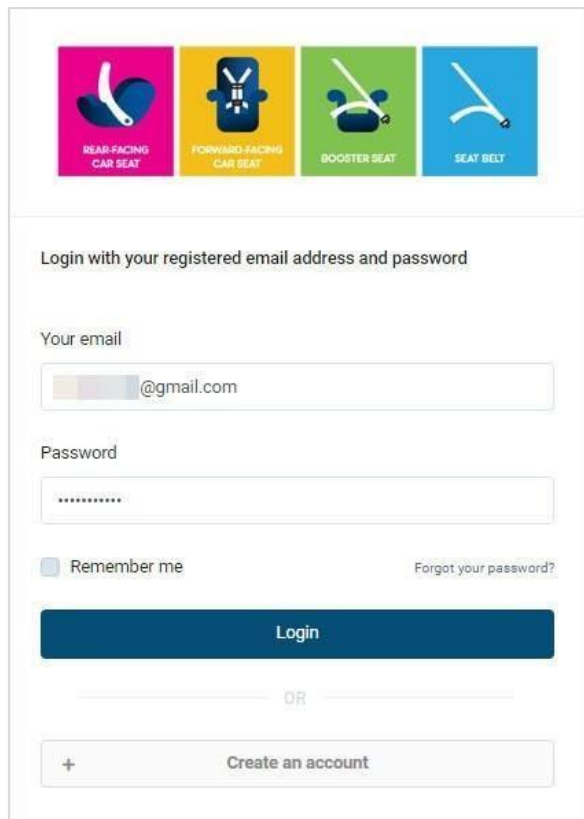
2. Open either the **New Account Created** email or the **New Course Enrollment** email.

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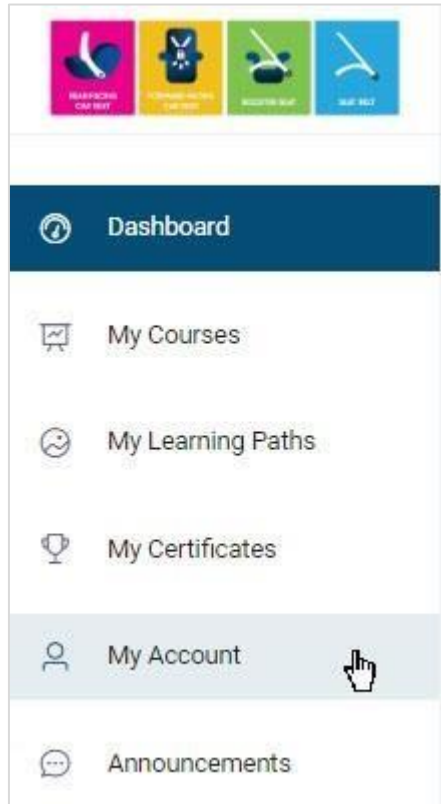
Both have links to login to the Learning Portal.

3. Login using the **username** (your email address) and the **temporary password** provided in the **New Account Email**.

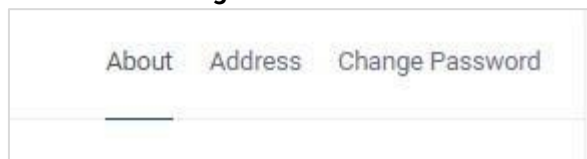

- b. Choose **Change Password** from the menu at screen right.

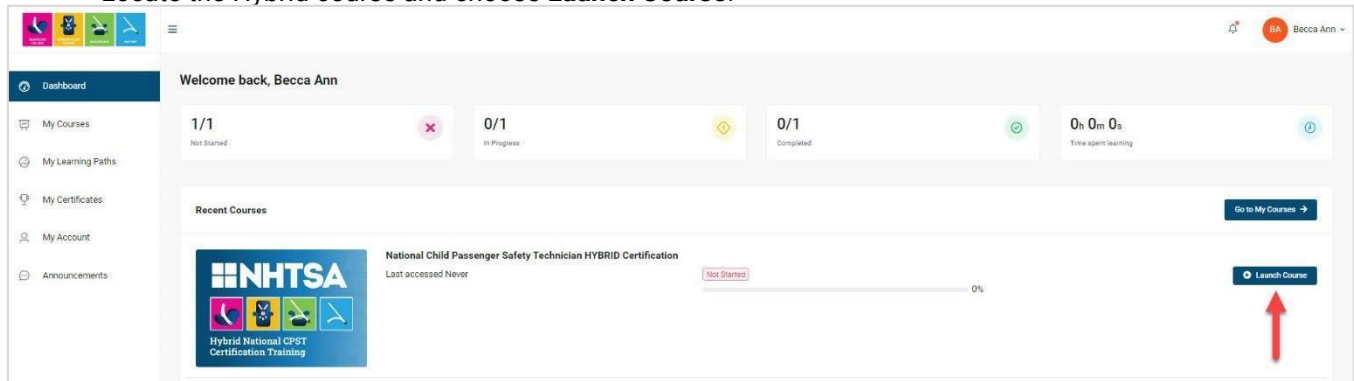


- c. Type your new password into the **Password** and **Confirm Password** boxes, then click the **Update Password** button.

6. The list of course modules displays.

- Modules must be completed in order.
- The **Launch Module** button becomes available for each new module as you progress through the course.



NOTE: Module is a term used by the Learning Portal to identify individual course segments. This term is hard-coded into the system and cannot be modified. The Hybrid course uses the term **segments** for the individual segments of the course, and the term **module** for the 13 main topic areas in the course. Within each of the 13 **modules** there are multiple **segments**.

Navigating through Segments

7. When you complete a course segment, you can progress to the next segment using the **Next Module** button in the top Navigation bar.

- If you want to return to the complete list of modules and segments, choose the **Back to All Modules** button.

- For course segments other than quizzes or the skills evaluation, you can **ignore** the **Total Time Spent** counter. There is no minimum or maximum time required in any segment other than quizzes.



Segment Types

TEXT SEGMENT

To complete a text segment, make sure you've read all the text and have scrolled to the bottom of the text if necessary. (Most text segments are very brief and don't require scrolling.)

PDF SEGMENT

PDF segments allow you to read and download a PDF file. **You must scroll to the end of the PDF file for the segment to mark complete.**

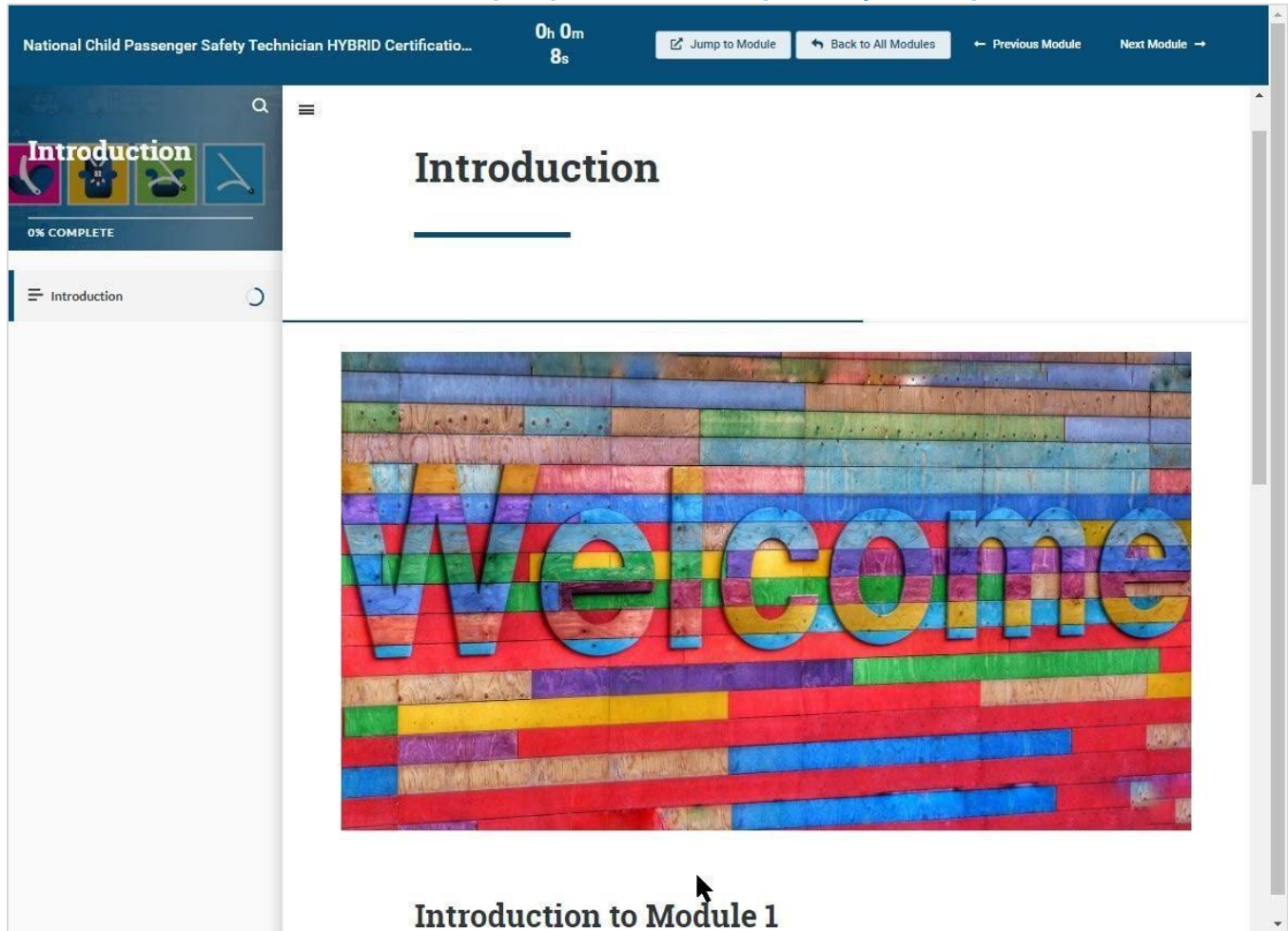

SCROLLING INTERACTIVE SEGMENT

Scrolling interactive segments feature content that you scroll through vertically. You must reach the last block in the segment for the segment to mark **complete**.

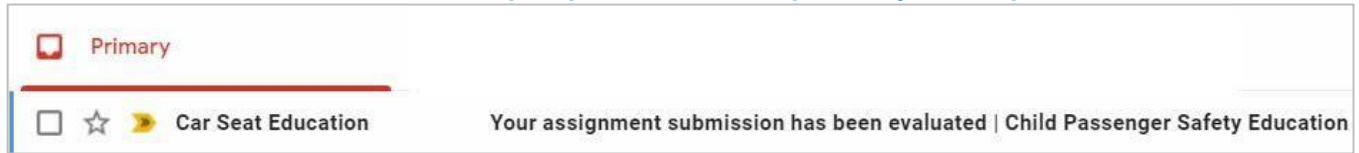
SLIDE-BASED INTERACTIVE SEGMENT

Slide-based segments look like presentation slides but have interactive components. You can view a list of all screens in the segment using the small hamburger-style menu control at screen left. You must reach the final slide in the segment for the segment to mark **complete**.

ASSIGNMENT SEGMENT

Assignment segments must be completed by the student and approved by an Instructor before the next segment will be unlocked for the student. To complete an assignment, type your response in the **Your Submission** box and choose the **Submit Assignment** button. You'll receive an email notification when the assignment has been approved.

Sample Assignment Segment



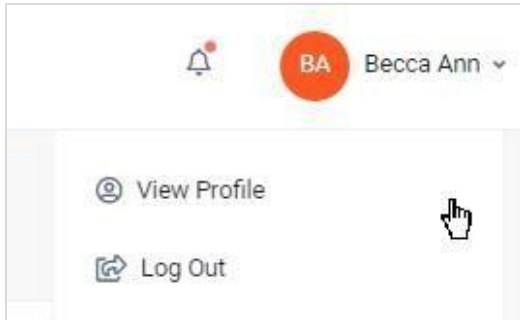
Sample Assignment Approval Email Notification

Log Out

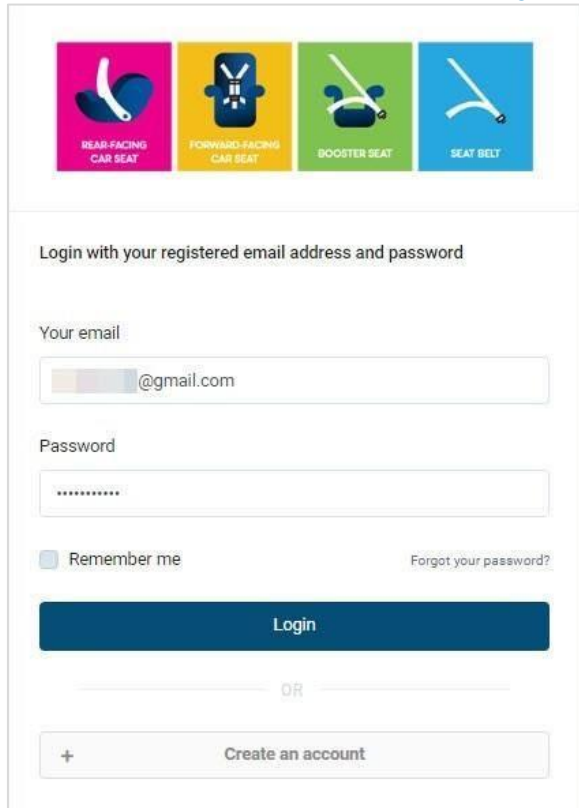
To log out, select your name at top screen right, and choose **Log Out**.

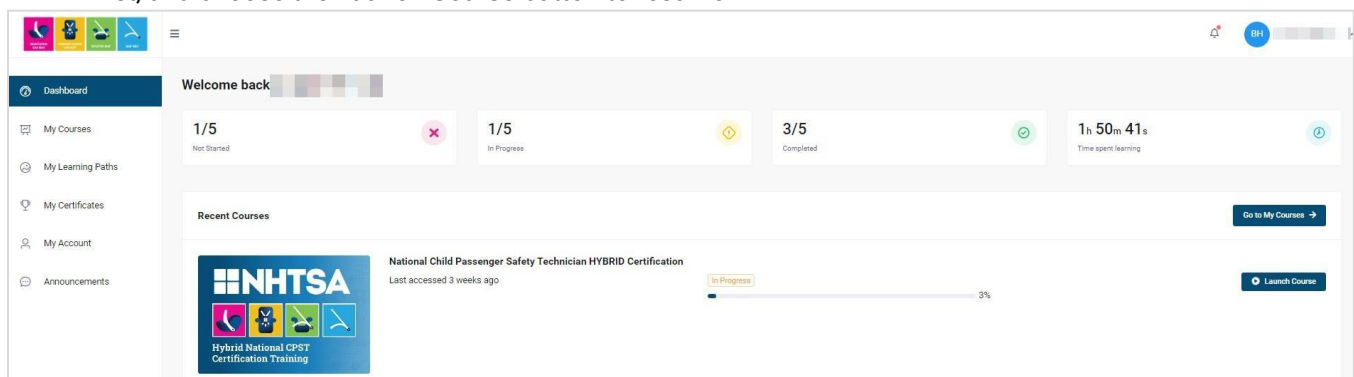

Devices

- ✓ The Hybrid Curriculum is playable on mobile devices.
- ✓ If playing the Hybrid Curriculum on a **convertible device**—a laptop PC with a tablet mode—use the mouse to navigate the e-learning screens.
 - Convertible devices operate using desktop operating systems, not mobile operating systems. These operating systems do not support the full range of touchscreen gestures.
 - Only mobile operating systems have the circuitry to allow all touchscreen gestures such as pinching, swiping, etc.

- ✓ While most segments are easy to complete via a mobile device, it is not recommended to complete more complex segments via a small mobile phone screen.
 - Tablet devices will work well, but mobile phone screens may be too small to see some of the images, which are critical to student success.
 - The course is highly dependent on detailed photographs and pages from car seat instruction manuals or vehicle owner's manuals. Therefore, for the best learning experience, take the course on a tablet, laptop, or desktop PC.
