- B. 7 mos., 24 lbs.
- C. 3½ yrs., 50 lbs., child with behavioral challenges
- D. 2 yrs., 30 lbs.
- E. 4 yrs., 45 lbs.
- F. 4½ yrs., 65 lbs.
- G. 3 yrs., 35 lbs., child with brittle bone disease

CSRS

- 1 Rear-Facing Only CSRS, 35 lbs. max
- 1 Convertible seat 35 lbs. rear-facing max and 50 lbs. forward-facing max
- 2 Combination CSRS, 65 lbs. max
- 2 Safety Vests
- 2 School Bus Only CSRS

All seating positions have lap belts.
