PEDESTRIANS-

National Safety Council

- Keep an eye out as you walk. **Look** and **listen**.
- If you see an unattended child in a vehicle, call 911. Have someone else search for the driver or ask the facility to page them.

CAREGIVERS-

- Open the back door of your car every time you park.
- Secure your phone, purse or briefcase in the back next to your car seat to ensure you look in the back before heading into the office.
- If someone else is driving, check to make sure your child has arrived safely.


