In this evaluation, you will install and adjust car seats or booster seats for 9 scenarios.

- **For Scenarios 1 to 3**, select and adjust the harness on the car seats based on the child's age, height and weight.
 - Answer scenario Sections A, B, and C per the car seat manufacturer instructions.
 - Select a different car seat (no repeats) for each scenario.
 - Be prepared to explain harness adjustment to the Instructor.
- **For Scenarios 4 to 9**, correctly secure the car seat or booster seat. Use the designated vehicles and seating positions. You will have an assigned car seat or booster seat at each vehicle. You will not select your own car seat or booster seat for this section.
 - Each scenario except #9 requires a separate installation.

Instructions

- Answer ALL sections for each scenario correctly to pass.
 - You **MUST** pass each scenario to pass Skills Evaluation 2.
 - You will have up to three attempts to pass each scenario.
 - Instructors will sign off on each attempt.
 - If you need a third attempt to pass, stop and review your Technician Guide (TG). A third attempt to pass must be signed off by an Instructor who has not already scored you for that scenario.
- After each scenario, you **MUST** be able to tell the Instructor how you arrived at each selection.
- Although we promote best practice, you must follow manufacturer instructions to pass.
 - For example, best practice is to keep a child rear-facing as long as possible.
 - However, if scenarios are within the height and weight limits of the car seat, the scenario is correct.
