Using Your Booster Seat with the Backrest

Child Requirements

- **Weight:** 18 – 45.3 kg (40 – 100 lbs)
- **Height:** 112 – 145 cm (44 – 57 in.) and tops of the child's ears are at or below the top of the booster seat headrest.
- **Age:** At least 4 years old

Shoulder Belt: Must cross midway between child's shoulder and neck.



Lap Belt: Stretched low and snug across the child's hips, beneath the armrests, and fastened into the buckle.
